Easter was marked with a range of activities throughout the home. Residents took part in crafts, enjoyed seasonal treats, and spent time together celebrating.

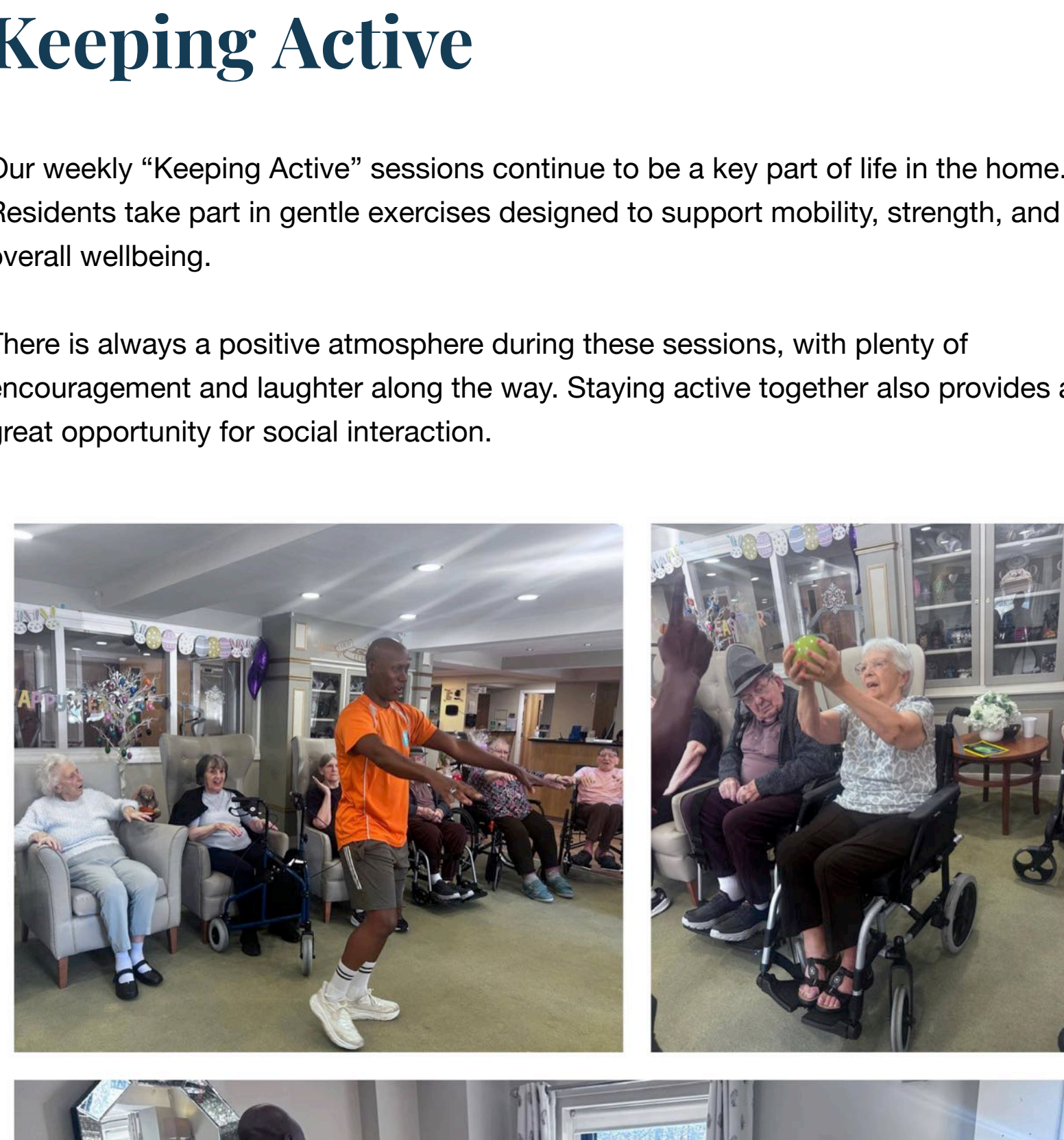

Keeping Active

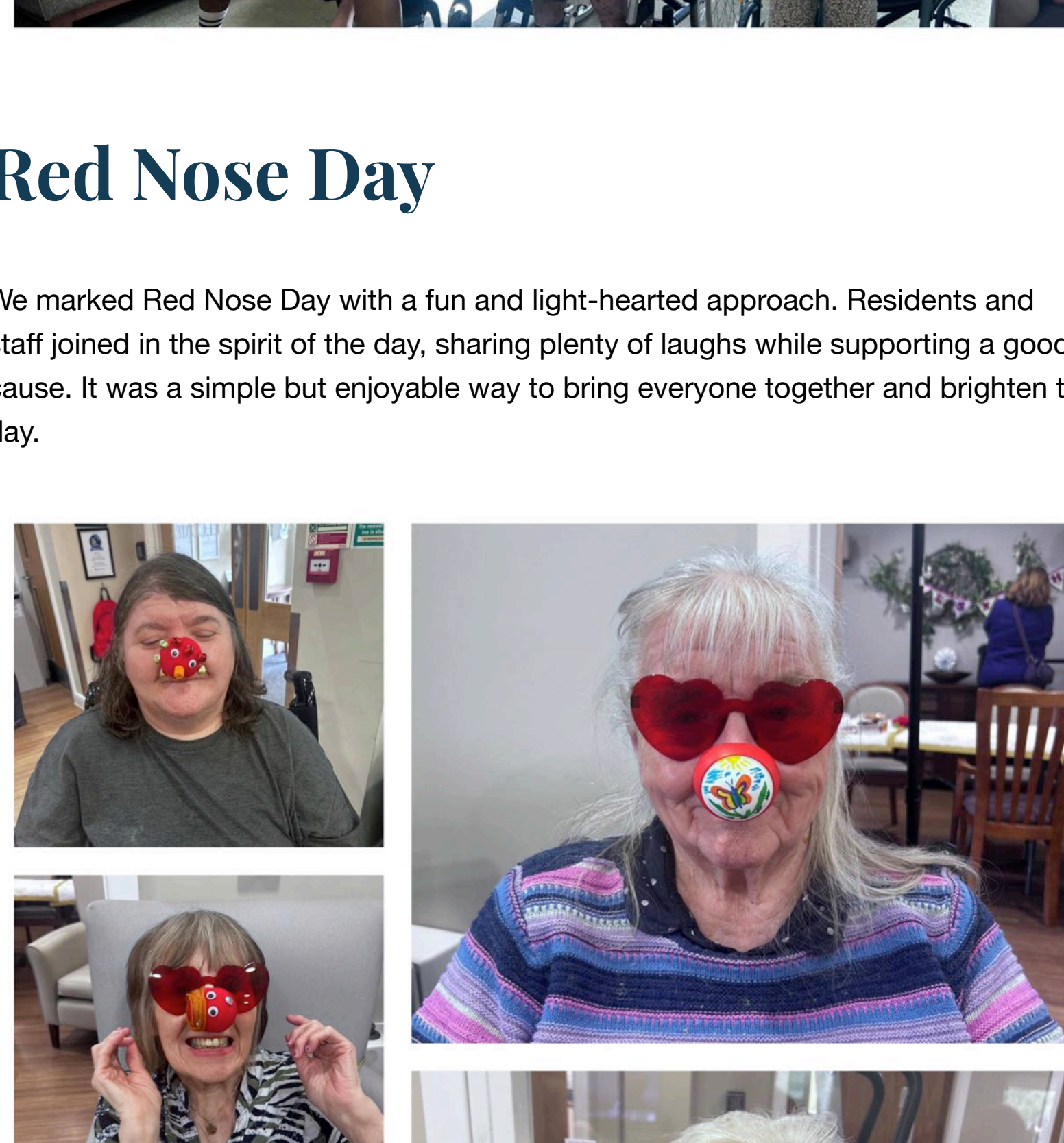

Red Nose Day

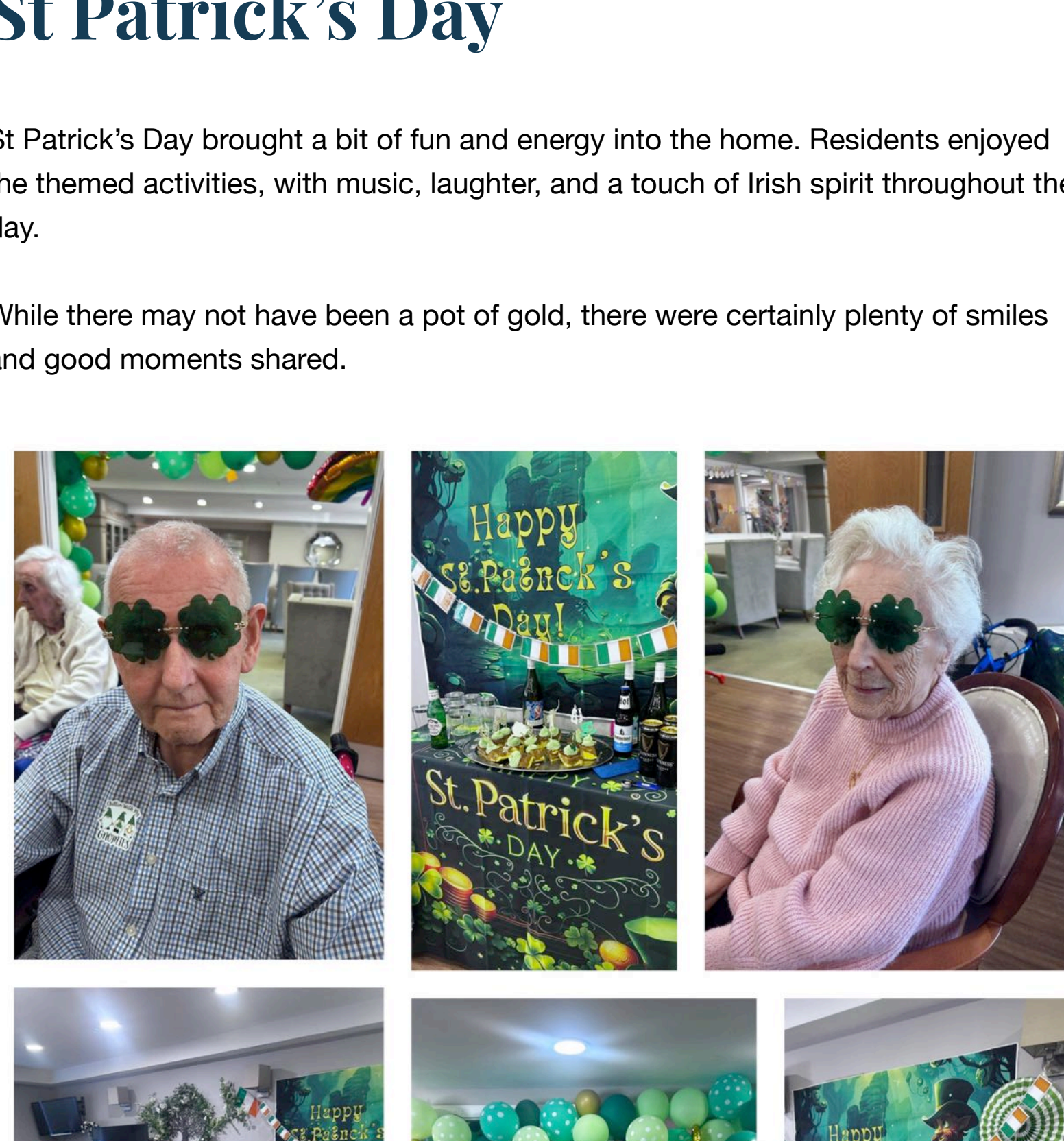

While there may not have been a pot of gold, there were certainly plenty of smiles and good moments shared.



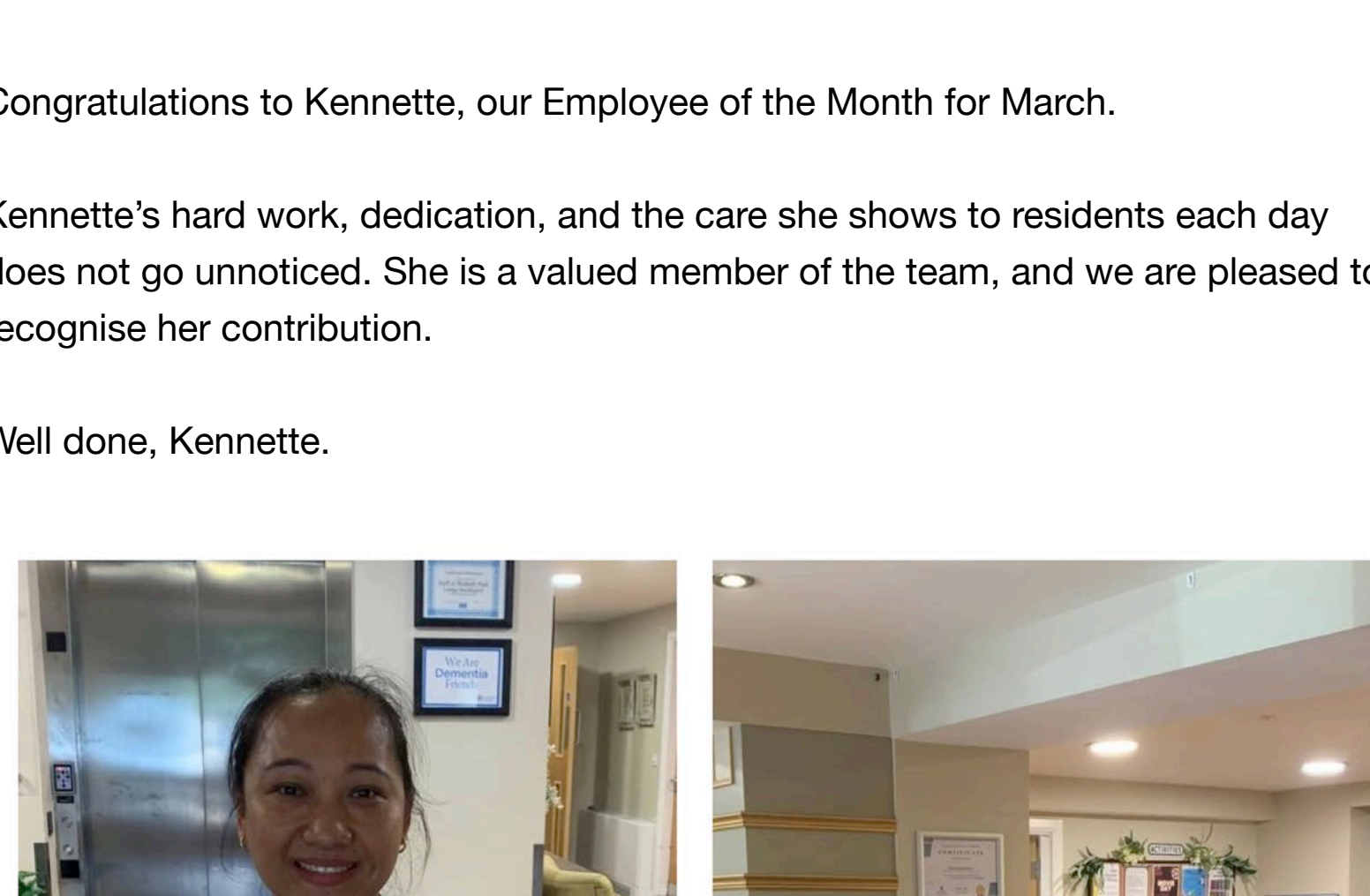

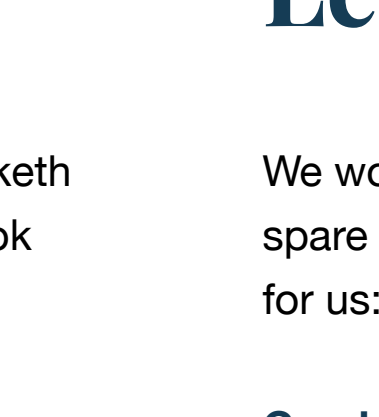
